Beginners Courses

Terms and Conditions



Entry Requirements

- The COAC Beginners Course Application Form must be completed in full by all applicants and submitted for approval via the COAC website.
- Applicants under the age of 18 years old must be accompanied by a legally responsible adult or guardian for the duration of the course.
- The club has an age restriction on the beginner's course of only accepting applicants over the age of 14 years old. This is because we have found that younger children are unable to achieve the shooting distances that the course requires also we do not have the equipment or set up to cater for children.

Application and Payment

- The Beginners course cost is £80
- Subject to approval of the application form a deposit of £40 per person will be required to secure a place on the course with the balance payable before the start of the course.
- All applications will be processed on a first come basis.
- In the case of multiple applications i.e. a group, then details of each individual will need to be provided together with a deposit for each applicant.
- Payment can be made on-line into the club account, refer to booking form for details.

Cancellation Policy

If for any reason you wish to cancel your booking before or part way through the course then full or partial charges (as below) may apply.

- Up to 2 weeks prior notice before the course: **No refunds**
- Between 2 – 4 weeks notice before start of course: **Deposit forfeited**
- Over 4 weeks notice before start of course: **Full refund**

Requests for cancellation should be made in writing to the Club Coach as soon as possible to allow the club to fill the place. Refund decisions are the responsibility of the Coaching Team.

Possible transfer to a future course (if available) will be reviewed on a case by case basis.

In the event that the course is cancelled due to short notice due to unforeseen circumstances, applicants will be contacted as soon as possible and either offered a full refund or the opportunity to attend a rearranged course.

Civil liability insurance

- Civil liability insurance is provided for non-members when attending a Beginners Course including the course of training and the associated shooting practice forming part of the course.
- The Civil liability insurance cover will only apply to beginners registered to attend the course.
- All beginners will be required to be supervised by members of the club coaching team when undertaking shooting.

Code of Conduct

- County Oak Archery Club is affiliated to Archery GB and abides by its policies and guidelines.
- Rules of shooting and etiquette will be outlined during the course.
- Any gross misconduct and/or inappropriate behaviour will result in the individual being requested to leave the course, forfeiting the course fee.
